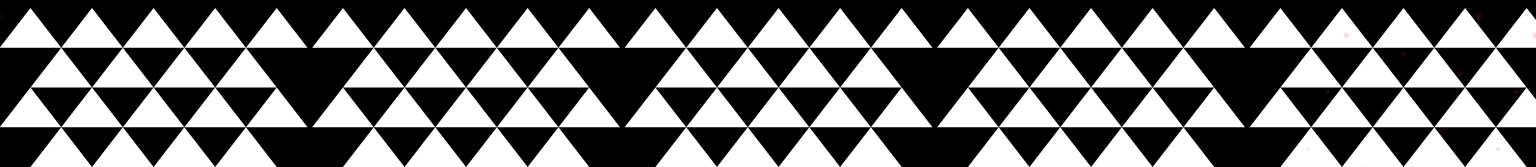
In the Year 2007-08 we had hosted the All India Inter-University Badminton (Men & Women) Championship.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

System of Play: The Championship will be played under FIDE's Law of Chess and the Swiss System. A total of Seven rounds shall be played. Pairing and standings will be based on the Match Point.

Teams from same college shall not be paired against each other in the last round. However, they may be paired if there is no compatible opponent with the same point group or score group with maximum difference of 2 match point. It is applicable only for the top 50% score of the penultimate round.

Starting Rank of the Team: The Seeding of the teams will be done on the basis of the average rating of the best 4 players. Players should send their entries with their FIDE ID and their respective FIDE Ratings. The fixed board order should be decided by the Team Captain/Manager before 07.00 pm on 20th Nov 2023.

Time Control: 60 mins + 30 Secs increment from move number 1.

Tiebreak: In case of Tie, the following is the order of Tiebreak

1. Match Points (2 for win, 1 for Draw & 0 for Losses)
2. Results of Team in the same point group according to match point (Direct Encounter)
3. Points (Game point)
4. SB - Wertung (Analog (57) but with all result)
5. Berlin System

Team Composition Board

4 Players playing A, B, C, And D

2 Extra players -: E and F

Protest: Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 1500/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals committee: Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member appeals committee shall be formed by the organizer during the technical meeting.

Interpretation: For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all.

Withdrawal: Any withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to the Chief Arbiter with acceptable reasons.

Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall. Those who are having mobile phones or wearing watches during their play will be declared lost.

Criteria for board prizes:

A- Team Score must have a minimum of 50% game points of the championship (14 points).

B-Percentage

C-Game descending

D-Ranking of teams

E-A, B, C and D Board has to play a minimum of 5 games

E, F- Extra players have to play 4 games

Forfeits points:

Walkover points: Match points 2, game points 4

Bye points: match points 1 games points 2

It is the responsibility of Captains/last Players to submit the result sheets, by filling it and signing it carefully.
